From the North: Take I-95 S to VA-30 (towards Kings Dominion); follow for approx. 20.5 mi.; turn left onto US-360E; destination will be on your right.

From West: I-64 E to exit 177 (I-295 towards Washington/Norfolk); Merge on to I-295 S; take exit 37A to merge onto US-360 E towards Tappahannock; follow 360 E for approx. 19 miles into Aylett; destination will be on your right.
